# PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING & COORDINATED ENTRY

Permanent supportive housing programs provide safe, stable homes through long-term rental assistance, paired with long-term intensive case management services, to highly vulnerable individuals and families with complex issues who are otherwise at risk of serious health and safety consequences from being homeless.

## Purpose

- Support clients by addressing barriers to self-sufficiency and maintaining housing
- Provide subsidized housing or rental assistance without preconditions along with necessary supportive services for individuals and families who would not succeed in other permanent housing settings.

## Client Engagement

- HMIS Data Entry/Updates/ Exit
- Facilitate application and program entry process
- Maintain low-barrier program requirements
- Regularly identify and assess client needs throughout program participation
- Eventually, move clients out of program to become self-sustaining

## Community Engagement

- Participate in case bi-weekly conferencing  
Notify Coordinated Entry Manager of vacancies and eligibility criteria to receive an appropriate referral from the community By-Name List  
Coordinated with front-end service providers (Street Outreach and Emergency Shelter) to ensure successful program enrollment
