# RAPID REHOUSING & COORDINATED ENTRY

Rapid Re-housing is an intervention designed to help individuals and families exit homelessness quickly and return to permanent housing. In a Housing First environment, Rapid Rehousing assistance is offered without preconditions (such as employment, income, absence of criminal record, or sobriety) and the resources and services provided are typically tailored to the unique needs of the household.

## Purpose

- Provide time-limited housing, financial, and case management services.
- Support clients experiencing homelessness identify and select among various permanent housing options based on their unique needs, preferences, and financial resources.

## Client Engagement

- HMIS Data Entry/Update/Exit
- Facilitate application and program entry process
- Exercise progressive engagement, offering "light touch" assistance at first, gradually increasing services as needed through ongoing evaluation.
- Regularly identify and assess client needs throughout program participation

## Community Engagement

- Participate in case bi-weekly conferencing
- Notify Coordinated Entry Manager of vacancies and eligibility criteria to receive an appropriate referral from the community By-Name List
- Coordinated with front-end service providers (Street Outreach and Emergency Shelter) to ensure successful program enrollment
