STREET OUTREACH & COORDINATED ENTRY

Street Outreach is designed to provide emergency services and engagement intended to link unsheltered households who are homeless to shelter, housing, and support services.

Purpose

- Provide low-demand, street and community-based services that address basic needs and seek to build relationships with the goal of moving people into housing and engaging them in services over time.
- Link clients with services such as a case manager, person-centered case management, psychiatric and addiction assessment, and other immediate and short-term programs.

Client Engagement

- HMIS Data Entry/Update/Exit
- Administer client assessment (VISPDAT, as soon as possible)
- Collect client documentation to support housing search (disability, income, and homeless verification)

Community Engagement

- Receive referrals from Access Sites
- Participate in bi-weekly case conferencing
- Coordinate with CE Manager and Permanent Housing providers to ensure successful referrals when the client is matched with a permanent housing resource.
