PROGRAM

The State ESG Program is designed to:

- ✓ Engage homeless individuals and families living on the street
- ✓ Improve the number and quality of emergency shelters for homeless individuals and families
- ✓ Help operate emergency shelters
- ✓ Provide essential services to emergency shelter residents
- ✓ Rapidly rehouse homeless individuals and families
- ✓ Prevent families and individuals from becoming homeless.



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FUNDING

Estimated Funding Available for Wake in
2019:

\$393,993

Emergency Services: \$236,396

Housing Stability: \$ 157,597



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ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

- **State ESG Priorities:**
 - Emergency Shelter
 - Rapid Rehousing
 - Street Outreach
 - Prevention

NC ESG funds are intended to be used as part of a crisis response system using a low barrier, housing-focused approach to ensure that homelessness is rare, brief, and one time.



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APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY

- ✓ Project Applicants
 - ✓ Nonprofit Organizations
 - ✓ Local Governments
- ✓ For-profit entities are not eligible to apply or be subrecipients

We will be modifying the HUD scoring tool for State ESG this year and will create an unbiased review panel to review and score all project applications.



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TIMELINE

The beginning:

- Advertise Information Meeting – completed via email
- Information Meeting – 8/1/2019
 - Forum to ask questions as needed
- Competition opened on 7/16/2019
- All applications are due to the ESG Office by 5:00 p.m. on October 11, 2019

2019 TIMELINE

- **July 16-** ESG application opened
- **August 30–** Applications Due to Partnership
- **September 17 –** Application Review (*2-weeks*)
- **September 20–** Partnership Board Votes on Rank and Tier
- **September 20–** Agencies Notified of Rank and Tier of Projects



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TIMELINE CONTINUED

- **Appeals Process:** Agency to submit within 72 hours of notification, Executive Committee to respond within 48 hours of receipt of request.
- **September 26**– Applicant meeting to peer review individual applications
- **October 11**– Community Application due
- **October 8** – Targeted date to submit Community application for Wake County CoC
